- A resume, which details his/her involvement in the sport including their NCCP coaching certification level and number, coach education and experience as a coach;
 - An outline of his/her coaching career objectives;
 - In indication of his/her ability to make a commitment to future community or competitive-level athletes;
 - A letter of reference from a board member or head coach of the team/club that they currently work with;
 - Proof of Respect in Sport (RiS) Certification (please provide RiS number or copy of certificate).
- **A Criminal Record Check (with Vulnerable Sector Screening) will be required for all coaches who are selected for the WIC program.**
